

## Microbiology and Immunology Diversity Scholars Program Application



The Microbiology and Immunology Diversity Scholars (MIDS) Program is an undergraduate research initiative established by the Graduate Program of Microbiology and Immunology (PMI) at the University of Pittsburgh. The aim of the MIDS Program is to promote diversity in STEM by engaging underrepresented-minority undergraduate students in long-term biomedical and/or public health research, career development, and mentorship in preparation for graduate-level education and careers in the biomedical sciences.

Eligible students must have a strong interest in microbiology or immunology. In addition, students must:

- Be able to commit a minimum of 10hrs/week to research for 10 weeks per semester.
- Be a member of a racial/ethnic group that is underrepresented in the biomedical sciences.
- Be ≥ 18 years of age and currently enrolled as an undergraduate at the University of Pittsburgh.
- Have completed at least 1 semester of undergraduate coursework.
- Have excellent communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills.

Ideal candidates have 2<sup>+</sup> years remaining of undergraduate coursework and are interested in pursuing graduate studies in a biomedical field.
